



## Exhibit Facts

### What?

A North American river otter exhibit called, *Otter Falls*, featuring two North American river otters.

### Where?

Atlantis Marine World Aquarium, 431 East Main Street, Riverhead, NY 11901

### Exhibit Description

A 1,500-square-foot exhibit footprint, constructed at a cost of \$1,000,000.00. Two North American river otters housed in a 1,000-square-foot enclosure with two 8-foot viewing windows at the pool and three viewing windows into the riverbank area. A 35-square-foot interactive Beaver Den is located at the rear of the exhibit, which allows guests a 3-foot underwater view into the pool. Another smaller viewing window is located mid-exhibit at the Day Den. The exhibit was aptly named for its two waterfalls, the 12-foot main waterfall greets guests as they approach the exhibit; a second 9-foot waterfall cascades into the pool. While much of the exhibit is man-made, the rocks that surround the pool have been collected from the Adirondack region, located in upstate New York.

### Admission

Included in Aquarium admission: \$21.00 plus tax / Adults 18-61; \$18.00 plus tax / Children 3-17 & Seniors 62+; Children 2 & under are free. Group rates are available with advance booking for parties of 15 or more (631.208.9200, ext. 105).
